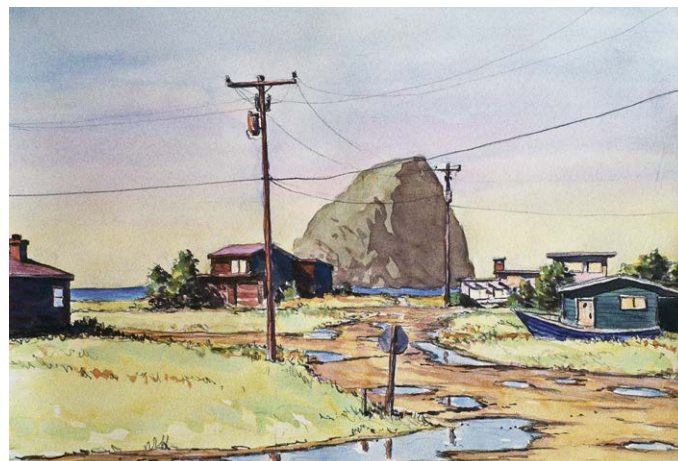
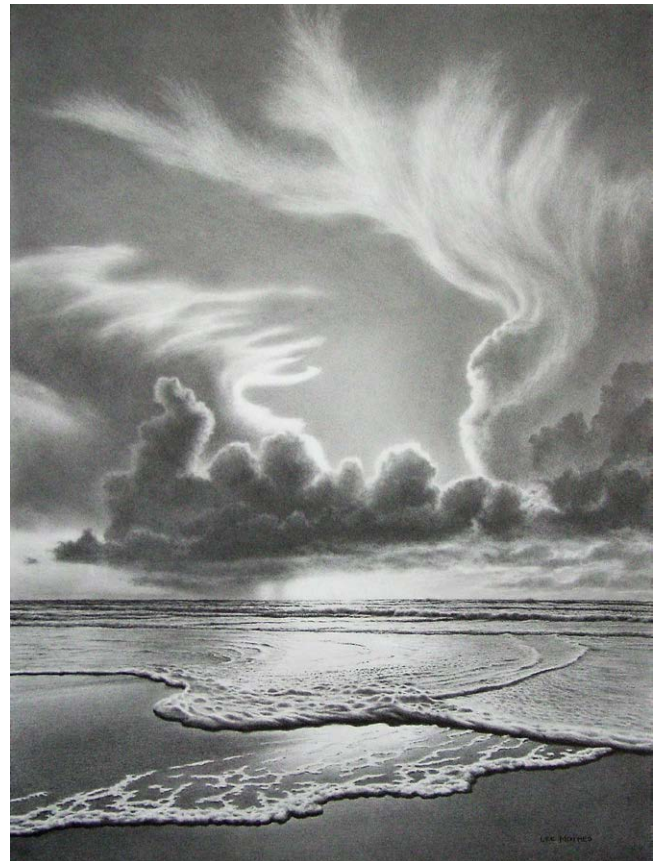

INSTRUCTOR LEE MOTHES

Each morning, Mothes will demonstrate different techniques in capturing cloud patterns, sunlight-on-water, and other natural forms. He will share what he has learned from 30 years of watercolor painting and pencil rendering, particularly landscape, beaches, water and skies. Lee will then work individually with each student to get started and develop ideas.

Students may choose to work in graphite pencil, in watercolor, or combine the two! Mothes will provide a complete list of paper, drawing tools and watercolor supplies to bring to class. Also, bring your own pastels, color pencils, or ink drawing pens of your choosing to explore and play with. Beginners are welcome, as well as accomplished students who want to learn new techniques.



Lee grew up by the Pacific Ocean and was enchanted by its energy at an early age. He began making pencil drawings as a kid, then tried using watercolors, then combined pencil and watercolor, then back to drawing, and so on.

After receiving a Bachelor's degree in art in 1980, he worked as a graphic artist and as a carpenter until 1990, when he opened his Oceans and Dreams studio. He returns to the West Coast once or twice a year to

promote his work and to get new ideas from actual observation on the beach.

Lee also teaches drawing and painting at the Renaissance School of Art at West High School in Appleton, Wisconsin.
