HOW TO ASSEMBLE THE Becky Taboret #880061

Thank you for your purchase of a Best Easel Becky Taboret. Your Taboret has been proudly manufactured in Kimberly, WI. Should you have any questions or concerns, please call us at 1-800-233-2404 and ask for customer service. Do NOT discard carton or packing materials until the unit is completely assembled.

Assembly of this Taboret is simple. We recommend referring to the photograph for confirmation as you go. For ease in assembly you should have two people in the first phase to remove the Taboret from the carton and turn over after inserting the legs. Once that is complete it is a one-person job!

Step 1. – Call the company you purchased from immediately should there be any damages to the carton or product before attempting assembly.

Step 2. – Using two people, lift the product from the carton and place on floor

Step 3. – Remove the 4 legs from the inside of the Taboret. Note each leg is numbered

Step 4. – Insert numbered leg in the matching numbered slot. Numbered end of the leg is placed into the numbered slot. Tighten the knobs to secure legs.

Step 4. – Remove all remaining loose parts from inside the Taboret.

Step 5. – With two people, turn the unit over to stand on the newly inserted legs. When lifting, be certain to lift securing the top of the Taboret with your hands so the top does not swing open.

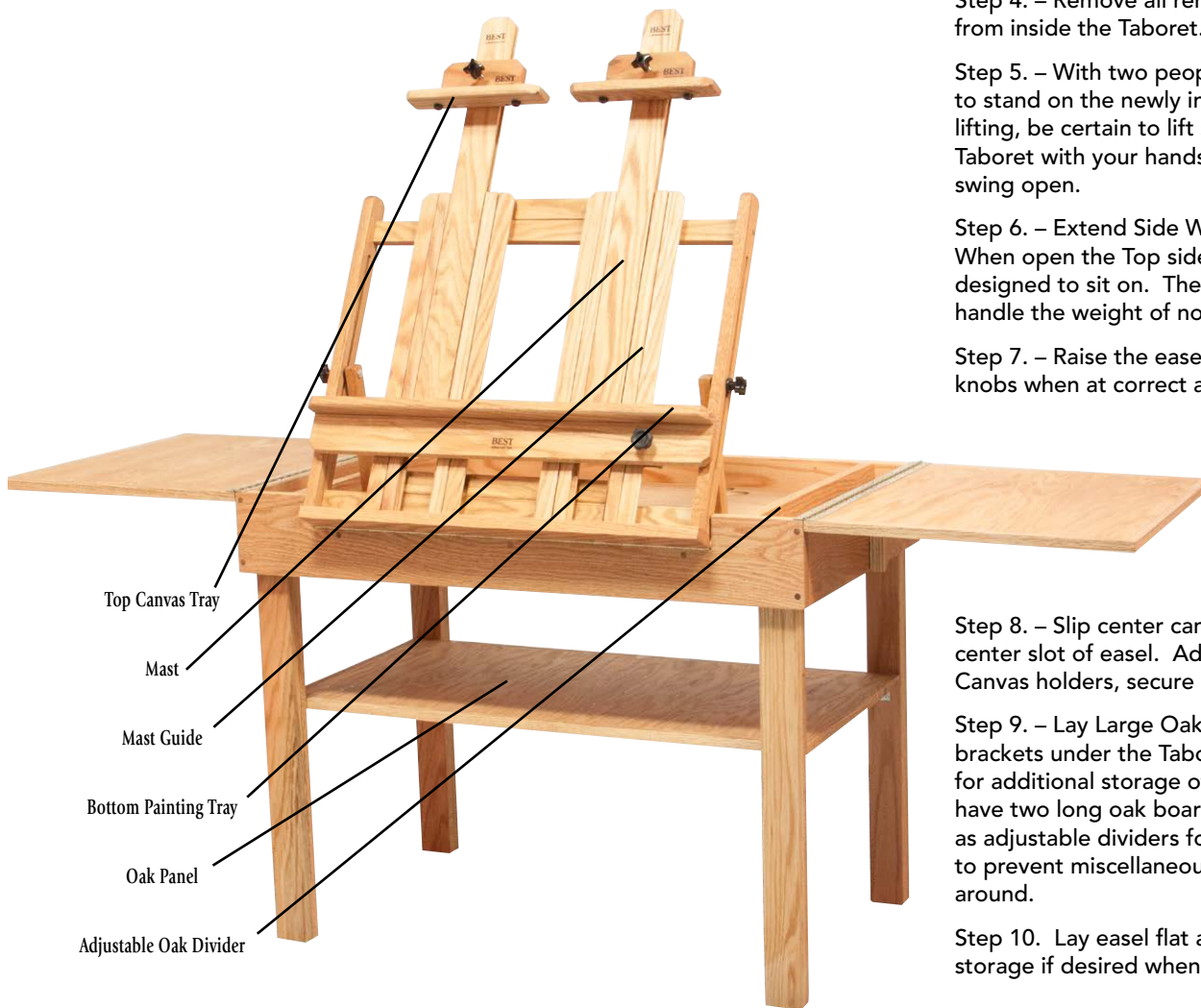
Step 6. – Extend Side Wings on open top. When open the Top side tables are NOT designed to sit on. They are designed to handle the weight of normal painting supplies.

Step 7. – Raise the easel and tighten side knobs when at correct angle.

Step 8. – Slip center canvas bar (Mast) into center slot of easel. Add Top and Bottom Canvas holders, secure by tightening knobs.

Step 9. – Lay Large Oak panel over metal brackets under the Taboret. This is designed for additional storage of supplies. You will also have two long oak boards. These are designed as adjustable dividers for inside your taboret to prevent miscellaneous supplies from rolling around.

Step 10. Lay easel flat and close top for storage if desired when not using unit.
