

This easel comes almost fully assembled except for a few items. The Van Dyne Easel is a very compact easel which once used, can be broken down to the very size it was delivered in. Begin by removing folding shelf, side trays, and metal back brace. Put these aside for now.

DIAGRAM 1. Swing the swinging base piece around and buckle into place. Screw metal handles into place and find metal pins. These pins are to help hold side trays into place. Place side tray in groove and make sure metal pin passes through slit in side tray.

DIAGRAM 2. Now find the folding back leg. Loosen knobs and unfold and slide leg into place. Take metal back brace and screw one end into easel back and the other to back leg.

DIAGRAM 3. Slide canvas support and mast up and attach canvas holders. If you haven't attached both side trays yet, do that at this time. Attach large folding shelf.
