
about Stephen Quiller



Stephen Quiller is an internationally known painter who works primarily in water media, monotypes, and intaglio printmaking. He is best known for his innovative approach to watermedia painting: watercolor, gouache, acrylic, casein and their combinations, and for his use of color. He has also written six books. His research and development of a color wheel for painters - called the "Quiller Wheel" - is now used by thousands of painters throughout the world. In addition, he has developed twelve instructional DVDs produced

by Crystal Productions, as well as two DVDs produced by Jack Richeson Co.

Stephen Quiller has painted in many parts of the world, but is primarily known for his work done at or near his home in the high mountainous country of southern Colorado. These subjects include beaver ponds, snow shadows, water patterns, wild iris, and mountain rhythms, capturing the spirit of the San Juans. Through his painting, he has become a Signature member of the American Watercolor Society, National Watercolor Society, Rocky Mountain National Water Media, and Society for Painters in Acrylic and Casein, among others. He received the Gold Medal of Honor in the 2014 American Watercolor Society International Exhibit in New York. A popular workshop instructor, he teaches his approach to color, water media, composition, and on-location painting, throughout North America and internationally.



DAY 1 Saturday September 5, 2020

Depart from U.S. Airport

Arrive in Italy on Sunday, September 6th.

If you are able to travel straight through - plan on 18-20 hours of travel.

Consider flying from the U.S. to Rome and connecting with Flights to Lamezia Terme airport

***You may find it easier to spend the night at a Rome/UK/European Hub Airport - traveling the next day to Lamezia Terme Airport / CODE:SUF. If this is preferred you will need to leave the USA on Friday September 4th, 2020*

DAY 2 Sunday September 6, 2020

A coach will meet all guests in the Arrivals area at Lamezia Terme Airport at 2:30pm with a 3:00pm departure for a 1 hour ride to the Kennedy Hotel in Rochelle Ionica - your home for the next 10 nights. NOTE: If you can not meet the group for the coach transportation - you will be responsible for your own travel to the hotel.

After a brief rest - we will meet for a Welcome Dinner and an early night.

Day 3 Monday September 7, 2020

We expect everyone to be suffering from some jet lag. This will be an easy day! Supplies will be handed out and instruction given from Stephen Quiller on how to set up your gear. He will give an initial talk and demo. We will spend the afternoon painting locally.

Lunch: On your own.

6:00pm: Dinner with the group.





The Adventure Begins

DAY 4 Tuesday September 8th – Day 10 Monday September 14th

The next 7 days will be filled with excitement and adventure!

Because we have not painted in this region before – Stephen Quiller asked we select the sites after he arrives several days before the group arrival. Steve, Colleen, and Fabiano (Those who were with us in Sardinia and one of the Ireland workshops should remember Fabiano) will carefully select the best possible painting sites for our group.

Please prepare for the trip by researching on line the Rochelle Ionica area of Italy. Feel free to pass any exciting details you uncover to: colleen@richesonart.com. You never know! We may want to check out your find when we arrive!

Details for the next day's painting and meals will be posted on a board near reception.

NOTE: Please prepare – you will need to purchase:

5 Lunches: (5 sack lunch days are included in your fee) Estimate between \$10 & \$20 each

2 Dinners: (8 dinners with the group are included as part of your fee) Estimate between \$25 - \$50 each dinner you buy.

DAY 10 Tuesday September 15, 2020

Today is sadly our last day. Following breakfast, painters will have a last chance to paint locally on your own.

Lunch: On your own.

After lunch, staff will meet with painters in small groups to help pack up gear.

Dinner: Farewell dinner and an early night.

DAY 11 Wednesday September 16, 2020

9am: Coach will leave for Lamezia Terme Airport

We strongly suggest you plan to fly to Rome or other Hub – spend the night and fly out to the US on September 17th. If you do this – you should be able to connect to anywhere in the lower 48 states on September 17, 2020

Passport

Passports are required for travel. We will require a copy of the picture page of your passport no later than March 1, 2020.

For moderately experienced painters. Guests should be able to lift 40lbs. of gear as well as walk for moderate distances. Ground is often uneven and paths are grass or rock.
